Each month, you will receive a list of three things that you can get, or do, to assemble a Basic Emergency Supply Kit. By following our recommended list you will have a well stocked kit by the end of the year.



Important Documents

For safekeeping, put copies of important documents such as passports, birth certificates, and photo IDs in your emergency kit.



Designate an Out of State Contact

In case local phone circuits are busy, or inoperable, designate someone to be an out of state contact.



Child Care Items

Formula, diapers, ointment, bottles and toys should be included in your emergency bag if you have children.
