Each month, you will receive a list of three things that you can get, or do, to assemble a Basic Emergency Supply Kit. By following our recommended list you will have a well stocked kit by the end of the year.



**Pet Photo**

Keep an updated photo of your pet(s) in your emergency kit. Also, put a copy of the license and ID tag with your pet's picture for easy identification in case your pet is lost in an evacuation or emergency.



**Pet Carrier/Leash**

For safe transport of your pet, include a carrier or a leash. This will help you evacuate your pet quickly and safely.



**Pet Supplies**

Pet food, snacks, toys, and medications are other pet items that you should consider putting in your emergency kit.
