

Require Signage at all Wading Pools and Spray Pools 333-060-515(3)

Wading Pool SAFETY SIGNAGE.

(a) Warning signs. Provide direct supervision of the wading pool, or place warning signs, in plain view, at the entrance(s) and inside the wading pool area.

Each sign is to read,

“WARNING: NO LIFEGUARD” in letters at least 4 inches (100 mm) high, and:

“PARENTS – Do not leave your children unsupervised” in letters at least 2 inches (50 mm) high.

If the pool is a spray pool or water playground without an enclosure, place the warning signs on four sides or not more than 50 feet apart, whichever is less.

(b) Wading Pool Rules.

Post a sign in a conspicuous location within the pool area that contains the following information in easily readable letters at least 1 (one) inch in height:

“Do not use the pool if you have had diarrhea in the last two weeks.”

“All persons, who are not toilet trained, must wear swim diapers.”

“Drinking and spitting of the pool water is discouraged.”

If the operator does not provide direct supervision, add:

“For emergency assistance please contact (insert 911, or other emergency assistance site staffed during all hours the wading pool is open).”

“Please contact (insert contact person or agency and phone number) with any concerns about this pool.”
