To ensure public and personal safety, the CHD Crisis Team provides 24-hour quality screening, evaluation, and stabilization to persons in Union County experiencing mental health emergencies.

We are able to bill most other insurance plans, and we provide services through contracts with many Employee Assistance Programs.

CHD is dependent on client fees to pay for the costs associated with treatment. However, no one will be denied clinical services because of an inability to pay. We do have funds available to assist a limited number of clients with the cost of treatment, based on clinical need, family size, and household income.
